What this website does

This website presents The Digital Kitchen Collective and its work and makes the association's research and related content publicly available. It also offers a sign-up form through which interested individuals can register to receive information about the association. Apart from the sign-up form, the website does not actively collect personal data from visitors, and it does not use analytics or tracking tools.

E-mail submission form

If you choose to register through the e-mail submission form, we collect your email address. We use this information to keep you informed about The Digital Kitchen Collective and to send you news or other communications about the association's activities from time to time. We do not currently operate a regular newsletter, but registration allows us to contact registered individuals when we have something relevant to share. You may withdraw at any time, with effect for the future, by writing to contact@tdkc.io. Withdrawing your consent does not affect the lawfulness of any processing carried out before withdrawal. We do not use this information for any other purpose, and we do not share it with third parties for their own purposes. The data is handled by our service providers (described below) acting on our behalf.

Cookies

This website does not use analytics, advertising or tracking cookies, and it does not use any non-essential cookies. For this reason, no cookie consent banner is displayed. The website may rely on strictly necessary or functional cookies set by our hosting and forms platform, for example to enable core site functionality or to allow the form to operate securely. Such cookies are technically required, do not track you across websites, and under applicable law do not require consent. If we

introduce any non-essential cookies in the future, we will update this Privacy Policy and seek your consent where required.

Contact by email

If you contact us by email, the information you provide (such as your name, email address and the content of your message) will be processed solely for the purpose of handling your enquiry. The legal basis for processing this information is our legitimate interest in responding to your enquiry (Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR; Art. 31(1) FADP). We do not use this information for any other purpose and we do not share it with third parties unless required by law.

Voluntary nature of data provision

Providing personal data through this website is entirely voluntary. There is no legal or contractual obligation to provide any personal data, and you face no consequences if you choose not to do so. If you do not register or contact us, we simply will not be able to send you information or respond to you.

Data retention

Personal data submitted through the sign-up form is retained for as long as you remain registered to receive information from us, or until you ask us to delete it or withdraw your consent. Other personal data is retained only for as long as necessary for the purposes described above, unless a longer retention period is required by law. Server log data is retained by our hosting providers for the period set out in their respective retention policies, which does not exceed the period necessary for security and stability purposes. We do not access or store this data separately.

Your rights

Subject to applicable law, you have the right to request access to the personal data we hold about you, and to request its correction, deletion, restriction of processing, or to object to processing.
